Sales of *Pick 'n' Mix* fund future productions and the modest profits will be donated to local charities/worthy causes; currently, we are working towards a donation to the Thrapston Branch of St John Ambulance, in order to assist its acquisition of a defibrillator.

Two of our members have recently published some of their own works independently in hard copy form: David Read, *Lines on God's Page*, a collection of faith poems, (also available on line), and Kevin Cooney, the first part of his autobiography, *Pulpits and Plain Sailing*, available either through him, Waterstones or Amazon.
