Report of the Independent Examiner to the trustees on the accounts of the Charity for the year ended 31 March 2024

Report to the Members, Trustees & the Charity Commissioners

Our committee year effectively starts at our AGM on the third Friday in May and at the start of this year there was a shuffle in the committee formation with a change to the Chairmanship and Vice Chairmanship, with the Vice Chairman also taking over the role of Speaker seeker. Our establised committee members continued to bring much enthusiasm to their roles.

Our first duty was to Chair the Northants Network meeting at Northampton on 9th June 2023.

Released from the shackles applied by Covid restirctions, we took full advantage of a fascinating programme of nine live Speakers at our monthly meetings covering a range of interesting topics.

Our next challenge was Thrapston Charter Fair, the annual public event held on 24th June 2023, a very sunny Saturday. Each year, this event brings many visitors and a great deal of joy to the town. The High Street closed to traffic and people throng the town centre for many tempting attractions. Naturally, it is a great chance to show off our U3A activities from our gazebo staffed throughout the day. Our presence extols the benefits of joining our U3A group. Although not its prime function, our tombola at the event raises a few pounds as well as being a fun thing to do.

For our meeting date in August, we set aside our usual format of a speaker at the Plaza and made our own entertainment at the Middle Nene Sailing Club, where our knowledge was challenged with a quiz. Our Social Committee had worked tirelessly to prepare a delicious buffet lunch and there was a raffle, all provided at very modest cost to members.

On 16th September 2023, we took to the streets with an organised Treasure Hunt, as part of a national initiative by the U3A to raise awareness of the movement, enjoyed by over 30 participants in groups and as individuals, with fine weather again.

New members coffee morning meetings were held at the Kings Arms in November and at Hermitage House care home in February 2024, both of which were well attended. Committee members were on hand to answer any questions that could have arisen.

Later in December 2023, in conjunction with Rushden & Higham U3A, several members made an arranged coach trip to the south coast for the ever-popular annual Tinsel & Turkey weekend.

The Christmas social was held on 15th December at The Plaza, with a take on the TV panel show "Blankety Blank" providing the entertainment. Our ever-enthusiastic social team worked to ensure that everyone had a good time. The tables were beautifully decorated and the food mouth-wateringly delicious. Mulled wine and other non-alcoholic refreshments were also available, along with a free-to-enter raffle.

Our Webmaster continues to update and guide us on requirement for the website and we are managing the updating of email addresses by expertise within the existing committee.

Membership renewals re-commenced in January with the annual subscription held at £20 per member and £2 per memer for attendance at the Plaza meetings. Our membership currently stands at 219 people.

Our Newsletter Editor does a splendid job producing a bright, interesting well illustrated edition every month in an easy-to-read format. It is vital to our smooth functioning as a proactive group besides being a wonderful record of our activities.
